The college is located on the Karnataka - Maharashtra border. Over 60 % of students enrolled are from Karnataka state. student enrolment from 2021-22 is presented.







Every year placement cell of our college organizes employability skill development programme in association with Tata consultancy services (TCS), Mumbai. The trainer from TCS trains the students for 100 hours on online mode followed by campus drive.

We inform colleges in the vicinity about the commencement of TCS-BPS employability skill programme. Students contact and register with placement cell of the college. The list is sent to HR manager of affirmative action, corporate social responsibility, TCS. The training is conducted by certified trainer. After completion of programme the campus drives are conducted by TCS for trained students. They prefer girls and SC, ST and EBC students.
